Mid-Del Technology Center presents an evening plumbing Certificate Program that is scheduled to begin in August 7, 2018. This program will consist of a series of courses designed to take the student through the theory of plumbing and provide shop and practical experience.

- This program is designed for students with little to no plumbing experience as well as apprentices currently working in the field.
- This program has the approval of the Construction Industries Board.
- Upon successful completion of the entire program, the student may apply for one-half year of experience required for taking the state journeyman's license exam.
