

FAQ's

Q: If my student's high school is closed due to COVID-19, do they still attend MDTC?

A: Yes, MDTC will notify students in the event of a closure to our campus.

Q: If my student's high school is closed due to COVID-19, will there be transportation?

A: MDTC has always provided transportation from Carl Albert High School and Del City High School. In the event, that the student's high school is closed due to COVID-19 we will continue to provide the bus from the parking lot of Carl Albert and Del City High Schools to MDTC and a bus to return the students back to the high schools. The students will have to find their own transportation to and from Carl Albert and Del City High Schools. Midwest City High School students have always walked from the high school to MDTC.

Q: If my student chooses to be a Virtual Mid-Del student, can they still attend MDTC?

A: Yes.

Q: If my student chooses to be a Virtual Mid-Del student, can they ride the bus?

A: A virtual Mid-Del student will need to provide their own transportation to and from MDTC.

Q: Are masks required at MDTC?

A: Yes, masks or neck gators are required to attend MDTC
