HEERF II - CRRSA

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA) provides funds to MidDel Technology Center for emergency financial aid grants to students for cost of attendance expenses and emergency costs that arose due to the coronavirus such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care.

Mid-Del Technology Center was allocated \$67,603 for student emergency relief aid under the CRRSA Act. Mid-Del Technology Center signed and returned the Certification of Agreement to the Department of Education and intends to use no less than \$67,603 of the funds received under § 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSA Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

The funds were distributed to all eligible adults who returned the HEERF II application (49 of 52 adults). 39 Full-time Pell Eligible Students Received \$1500 across the board 6 Full-time Non-Pell Students Received \$1200 across the board 1 Part-time Pell Student Received \$703 3 Part-time Non-Pell Students Received \$400 across the board Ad of April 30, 2021, 100% of the CRRSA Emergency Financial Aid for Eligible Adults Students has been awarded and disbursed to eligible adults.
