

Program Overview

Mid-Del Technology Center offers full-time career pathways to high school juniors, seniors and adults. Courses are offered from 7:45a.m.– 10:25 a.m. and 11:20 a.m.– 2:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Adults can choose to attend either the AM, PM or both sessions depending on availability. Students are encouraged to begin the program in August and complete in May, but flexible entry and exit dates may be considered. Adult students will take the TABE entrance exam before being considered for a program. Students may request accommodations for testing through the Student Services office. Please see page 2 for tuition, fees, and other financial information.

Auto Collision Repair will prepare students to complete non-structural collision repair and automotive refinishing. The courses that will be covered include non-structural damage analysis and minor dent repair, plastics repair, all aspects of painting and refinishing. Students will also learn how to use various tools in repairing damage and to remove and install handles, moldings, trim, and bolted body parts. In addition, the student will learn to MIG weld industry standard joints following I-CAR standards. This career major also includes painting preparation, sanding processes, color matching and adjusting color, removing and installing glass, and the process of written estimates. Students will learn about handling, storage and disposal of hazardous materials and selecting proper personal protective equipment and maintenance. Students will have the opportunity to earn I-CAR certifications as part of the program curriculum.

Payment Plan: Payments are due by the 10th of each month.

- Payments will be divided into 8 equal payments per year of attendance with the first payment due Sept 10th or Jan 10th, depending on the date you start the program.
- A late fee of \$100.00 will be applied for payments not received by the 10th of the month.
- All accounts must have a \$0 balance before completing the program.
- Students with an outstanding balance WILL NOT be allowed to take Certification Exams.
