

Course Name: Anatomy & Physiology (Online)

## **Course Description:**

Anatomy and Physiology is the study of the structural complexities of the human body and its intricate functional mechanisms. In this course, students will learn and demonstrate a basic understanding of the following body systems: Organization of the Body; Chemical Basis for Life; Cells, Tissues, and Membranes; Integumentary System; Skeletal System; Muscular System; Nervous System; Endocrine System; Blood; Cardiovascular System; Lymphatic and Immune Systems; Respiratory System; Digestive System; Urinary System; and the Reproductive System. This course meets the prerequisite requirement for the Practical Nursing (PN) program at Mid-Del Tech Center.

- 1. Use correct terminology to discuss the chemistry, cell structure, and tissues of the human body.

- 3. Identify and explain the structure and functions of each body system.
- 4. Discuss diseases, disorders, and conditions commonly found in healthcare occupations.
- 5. Explain the role of each body system in maintaining homeostasis.
